Seeking Public Comments for Wickenburg Trails & Vulture Mountains Recreation Plans

(WICKENBURG)—Are you interested in improving recreational opportunities and facilities in the greater Wickenburg area? If so, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and Maricopa County Parks and Recreation Department invite you to share your ideas at a public master planning meeting on Saturday, December 11 from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. The meeting will take place in the Media Room of Wickenburg High School located at 1090 South Vulture Mine Road.

Topics of discussion include the BLM's Wickenburg Community Master Trails Plan and possible recreational opportunities for the Vulture Mountains area. In addition, the agencies will share information on current projects such as the identification and development of a trail network, management plans for natural areas and potential recreational facilities. The Vulture Mountain Plan will be presented from 9:30 to 11:30 a.m.. The Wickenburg Trails Plan will be presented from noon to 3 p.m.

An environmental analysis of various trail scenarios for the Wickenburg Community Master Trail Plan is also being conducted. Soliciting community feedback (scoping) for the analysis at this meeting will start the analysis process. Materials will be available to facilitate scoping.
